SUBJECT: Permission to occupy both sides of Thoroughfare  
with Class "B" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of December 30, 1954, permission to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Mountain View-Stevens Creek Road for a distance of 3,100 feet south of Homestead Road near Monte Vista, Santa Clara County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of October 22, 1954 indicated it is agreeable to the continuance of such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Mountain View-Stevens Creek Road for a distance of 3,100 feet south of Homestead Road near Monte Vista, Santa Clara County, substantially as shown on the plan map marked Proposed Occupancy of Both Sides of Mountain View-Stevens Creek Road with Class "H" Circuits Monte Vista Suburban Santa Clara County 9-14-54 submitted with its request of December 30, 1954.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
