SUBJECT: Request for Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of December 30, 1954, permission to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Ashlan Avenue between Marks and West Avenues near Fresno, fresno County for a distance of 5,540 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAG: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of October 17, 1954 indicated it is agreeable to such occupancy, with the request that on replacement of certain poles in this section, space be provided for the telephone company's future use,

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Ashlan Avenue between Marks and West Avenues near Fresno, Fresno County for a distance of 5,540 feet substantially as shown on the plan map marked Plat 13203, Loc. Est. E-27545 submitted with its request of December 30, 1954 subject to the provision that on future poles replaced in this section supporting a maximum of 13,500 volts, space be provided for said telephone company's use.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
