SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested by letter of February 1, 1955, permission to install a Glass "H" line opposite an existing Class "H" line of another electric utility on portions of Seventh Avenue and "H" Avenue, gest of Stratbaore, Tulare County for approximately 9,911 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Comercal Telephone Company of California and Southern California Edison Company have by letters empressed approval of the proposed dual occupancy of the said thoroughfares,

IT is MERGET ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to install Class "M" circuits on the south side of Seventh Avenue easterly from Cairns Avenue to "M" Avenue, a distance of approximately 7,974 feet, and the east side of "M" Avenue south from Seventh Avenue a distance of approximately 1,937 feet, west of Strathmore, Tulare County. The construction to be substantially the same as shown on the plan maps marked Exhibit "A", Exhibit "B", and Exhibit "C", submitted with its request of February 1, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
