SUBJECT: Permission to Deviate from Rules 54.7-A and 54.7-A3b, General Order No. 95

WHEREAS: ANZA ELECTRIC GOOPERATIVE, INC., having requested by letters of January 31, 1955 and February 24, 1955, persission to deviate under specified construction conditions from the provisions of General Order No. 95 which require that climbing space be maintained 4 feet vertically, both above and below each conductor level through which it passes, and the requirements of said order which relate to leaving certain pinholes in line arms and/or buckarms vacant. and

WEEREAS: In the absence of such permission, such construction would be a violation of Rules 54.7-A and 54.7-A3b of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: It appears that under the certain limiting conditions under which the request is made, such construction will not provide less safety than is provided in the order, and that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREST Children that permission be granted to Anza Electric Cooperative, Inc. to deviate from Rules 54.7-A and 54.7-A3b of General Order Mo. 95 to the following extent and with the limiting conditions set forth below:

The requirement of Rule 54.7-A that climbing space shall be maintained for a distance of not less than 4 feet vertically, both above and below each conductor level through which it passes, and the requirements of Rule 54.7-A3b which relate to leaving certain pinholes in line arms and/or buckarms vacant, shall not be held to apply to a single circuit of more than 7,200 volts in horizontal configuration at the top of the pole, provided;

- 1. No portion of any conductor on the lower arm of related line and buckarm of such a circuit, or jumpers connected thereto, shall be a lesser radial distance from center line of pole than that required by Rule 37, Table 1, Case 8, and
- 2. Where line arm and related buckarm are present, climbing space as required by Eule 54.7-A2 shall be maintained through the level of the conductors on the lower arm for a distance of not less than 4 feet below such conductor, up to the level of conductors on the upper arm, but need not extend through the level of the conductors on the upper arm. and
