SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

IT IS MERREDE ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Wildwood Road for a distance of 2,579 feet southerly from Bresser Avenue near Masco, Kern County, substantially as shown on the plan map marked "Loc. Est. B-29222" dated January 21, 1955, submitted with said company's request of March 9, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
