SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having requested, by letter
dated March 9, 1955, permission to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of
Wildwood Road for a distance of 2,579 feet southerly from Dresser Avenue near
Wasco, Kern County, such occupancy to be on a joint-pole basis with The Pacific
Telephone and Telegraph Company as described by said letter, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission such occupancy would constitute
a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95 of this Commission, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has, by letter of
March 1, 1955, indicated it is in agreement with such proposed occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and
Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Wildwood Road
for a distance of 2,579 feet southerly from Dresser Avenue near Wasco, Kern
County, substantially as shown on the plan map marked "Loc. Est. E-29222" dated
January 21, 1955, submitted with said company's request of March 9, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to
be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this
authorization.
