SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Service Agreement Under Section I,
Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, having submitted for filing, and having requested authorization to carry out the terms of an agreement with the Pacific Electric Railway Company dated September 13, 1954, which agreement provides for electric service to the Railway Company for a two-year period from September 13, 1954, and thereafter for successive two-year terms, under filed rates but under conditions which differ from the filed tariffs of Southern California Edison Company, and the Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company be authorized under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and provisions of said agreement, and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement herein authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-885 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
