SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter
of April 14, 1955, permission to continue to occupy with Class "H" lines
both sides of Ashlan Avenue near Fresno, Fresno County, for approximately
7,921 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute
a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter
expressed approval of the proposed dual occupancy of the said thoroughfare.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and
Electric Company to continue to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides
of Ashlan Avenue westerly from Polk Avenue for a distance of approximately
7,921 feet to Grant Avenue near Fresno, Fresno County, the construction to
be substantially the same as shown on the plan map marked Local Estimate
E-29028 submitted with its request of April 14, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to
be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this
authorization.
