SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Agreement under Section X,
Paragraph A of General Order No. 96

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY having submitted for filing, and having requested authorization for, an agreement with the Los Angeles Transit Lines dated September 13, 1954, which agreement provides for electric service under rates and/or conditions which differ from the filed tariffs of the company, from the 13th day of September, 1954, and thereafter for successive terms of two years each, terminable upon the expiration of said original term or any extended term by either party giving the other 90 days' written notice, and the Commission being of the opinion that such authorization should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company be authorized under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the provisions of said agreement in accordance with the terms thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the agreement hereinbefore authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution No. E-890 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
