SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "N" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of May 20, 1955, permission to install Class "N" lines for 1,386 feet and approval of 7,893 feet of existing Class "N" lines along both sides of McCall Avenue, near Sanger, Fresno County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter expressed agreement to the proposed dual occupancy of the thoroughfare provided that on any future 12-kv pole replacements in this section, space be provided for the telephone company's future use.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "N" circuits both sides of McCall Avenue beginning at a point approximately 2,050 feet south of McKinley Avenue to 2,250 feet north of Shields Avenue, a distance of 9,279 feet, more or less, near Sanger, Fresno County, the construction to be substantially the same as shown on the plan map marked Loc. Est. E-29432 submitted with its request of May 20, 1955, provided that on any future 12-kv pole replacements appropriate space be provided for communication facilities.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
