SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare  
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of May 24, 1955, permission to install Class "H" lines for 1,415 feet and approval of 3,024 feet of existing Class "H" lines along both sides of Healey Road, near Merced, Merced County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter expressed agreement to the proposed dual occupancy of the thoroughfare provided that on any future 12-kv pole replacements in this section, space be provided for the telephone company's future use.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Healey Avenue from a point 2,688 feet north of the corner of Sections 21, 22, 27, and 28, T.23, R.14E SDBM to approximately 1,751 feet south of said Section corners, a distance of approximately 4,439 feet, near Merced, Merced County. The construction to be substantially the same as shown on a plan map marked Loc. Est. No. 2-12242 submitted with its request of May 24, 1955, provided that on any future 12-kv poles or replacements, appropriate space be provided for communication facilities.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
