SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules on
Less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by Advice No. 247, filed
June 8, 1955, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff
schedules as designated in Rule and Regulation No. 9, set forth on Cal.
P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2653-B to 2655-B, inclusive, to become effective on
June 22, 1955, which is less than 30 days' notice, and


WHEREAS: Said revisions to Rule and Regulation No. 9, Discontinuance of
Service, provide that company may discontinue service after five days
written notice in the event customer fails to make a credit deposit in
accordance with his representations; and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the
Public Utilities Code to make the above-mentioned tariff sheets effective
on and after June 22, 1955.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said tariff sheets shall be marked to
show that such sheets were authorized under Resolution No. E-894 of the
Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
