SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules  
on Less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by advice No. 248-B, filed June 18, 1955, having requested authority to file its tariff schedule designated Rule and Regulation No. 31 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2656-B to 2658-B, inclusive, to become effective on July 6, 1955, which is less than 30 days' notice, and

WHEREAS: Said Rule and Regulation No. 31, Underground Line Extensions, provides for the extension of underground distribution lines of standard voltages to furnish permanent service to groups of individuals and to real estate subdivisions in all of the company's operating areas except those areas in which the company maintains such underground distribution facilities for its operating convenience; and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above-mentioned tariff sheets effective on and after July 6, 1955.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that said tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized under Resolution No. E-896 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
