SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfares with Class "N" Lines

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC FOWER COMPANY, having requested by letter of May 24, 1955, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of a portion of Donlon Street in Blythe for approximately 2,946 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Coloredo River Telephone Company has by letter of May 17, 1955, expressed approval of the proposed occupancy on both sides of the public thoroughfere provided that space be allowed on the poles for telephone cables.

IT IS HEADET ORDERED that permission be granted to California Electric Power Company to occupy with Class "E" circuits both sides of Doulon Street from a point west of Main Street, east to Fifth Avenue, a distance of 2,946 feet, within the city limits of Blythe, the construction to be substantially the same as shown on plan map marked D7-310 submitted with its request of May 24, 1955, and provided that space be allowed on the poles for installation of communication facilities.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the California Electric Fower Company of the granting of this authorization.
