SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY HAVING requested by letter of June 17, 1955, permission to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 58K for 1,285 feet more or less, west of Tracy Avenue, and

WHEREAS: The permission requested is to extend a similar occupancy approved by this Commission by Resolution No. 8-814 on August 10, 1953, and

WHEREAS: The only other pole-using utility in the area has by letter of June 2, 1955 to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, stated it is agreeable to the proposed construction, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" lines both sides of California State Highway Route No. 58K, near Buttonwillow, Kern County, for a distance of 1,285 feet, more or less, west of Tracy Avenue as shown on the plan map included with its letter of June 17, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
