SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, having requested by letter of July 19, 1955, permission to continue the occupancy with Class "H" lines of the south side of Santa Monica Boulevard in Los Angeles City and Los Angeles County, and

WHEREAS: The City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power has existing Class "H" lines on the north side of Santa Monica Boulevard, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission Edison's occupancy constitutes a violation of Rule 31.3 of G. O. No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of July 12, 1955 stated that it has no objection to the continued occupancy of the public thoroughfare,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Southern California Edison Company to continue the occupancy with Class "H" circuits of the south side of Santa Monica Boulevard, extending from 200 feet east of Van Ness Avenue, in Los Angeles City, west to Orlando Avenue in Los Angeles County.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
