SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with  
Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of July 14, 1955, permission to install Class "H" lines on both sides of McCall Avenue for 149 feet north of Kings Canyon Road, near Fresno, Fresno County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of July 6, 1955 expressed agreement to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of McCall Avenue for 149 feet north of Kings Canyon Road, near Fresno, Fresno County. Construction to be substantially as shown on a plan map designated as Loc. Est. E-29976 submitted with its request of July 14, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
