SUBJECT: Permission to Deviate from Rule 86.9 of General Order No. 95

WHEREAS: GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, having requested by letter of January 11, 1955, permission to deviate from the provisions of General Order No. 95, which require that the protection of anchor guys exposed to traffic must be protected with a wood or metal guard, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, such construction would be a violation of Rule 86.9 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: It appears that the plastic tubing will provide substantially the same protection of anchor guys and will provide for certain economies by their use, and that the requested permission should be granted, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to General Telephone Company of California to deviate from Rule 86.9 of General Order No. 95 to provide that guy guards may be made of a durable plastic tubing of such color so as to provide approximately the same light reflectivity as guards constructed of wood or metal now in use.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said company of the granting of this permission.
