SUBJECT: **Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "N" Lines**

WHEREAS: **PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY**, having requested by letter of September 8, 1955, permission to continue to occupy with Class "N" lines both sides of Orange Avenue from California Avenue to Church Avenue in Fresno County, for approximately 1,135 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of August 2, 1955, indicated approval of continuation of such occupancy.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to continue to occupy with Class "N" circuits both sides of Orange Avenue from California Avenue to Church Avenue in Fresno County, a distance of approximately 1,135 feet, as shown on the plan map dated July 12, 1955 and marked P.U.C. citation item No. 50 submitted with its request of September 8, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
