R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
 with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of November 8, 1955, permission to install Class "H" lines on both sides of El Dorado Street between the Mormon Channel and Anderson Street, a distance of 1,250 feet, and on B Street between Hazelton and Jackson Streets, a distance of 1,485 feet, in the city of Stockton, San Joaquin County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has, by letter of October 27, 1955, expressed agreement to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of El Dorado Street between the Mormon Channel and Anderson Street, a distance of 1,250 feet, and on B Street between Hazelton and Jackson Streets, a distance of 1,485 feet, in the city of Stockton, San Joaquin County; construction to be substantially as shown on plan maps, sheets 2 and 3, submitted with its request of November 8, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
