SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare  
with Class "H" Lines.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of December 30, 1955, permission to install Class "H" lines on both sides of Airport Boulevard, South San Francisco, San Mateo County, for a distance of 3,594 feet,

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has, by letter of December 13, 1955, expressed its accordance to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Airport Boulevard, South San Francisco, San Mateo County, a distance of 3,594 feet; construction to be substantially as shown on plan map, drawing No. 2-2699, GM 131831, dated October 19, 1955, submitted with its request of December 30, 1955.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
