SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules Which
Will Result in Increased Rates or Charges

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 141-E, filed on January 20, 1956, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedule as designated in Schedule PA-7, Agricultural Power Service - Limited Use, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2636-E, to become effective on February 19, 1956, which said revision will result in increased charges of a minor nature to seven existing customers,


It appearing that such conditions or charges as will result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2636-E effective on February 19, 1956.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution No. E-918 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
