SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 156-E, filed January 31, 1956, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Supplement No. 2 of Schedules P-2 and R and Table of Contents, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1035-E, 1036-E, and 1037-E, to become effective on February 22, 1956, which is less than 30 days' notice, and


WHEREAS: It appearing that said schedules should be made effective on less than statutory notice and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California to make the above-mentioned sheets effective on February 22, 1956, which is less than 30 days' notice.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-919 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
