SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules which may Result in Increased Rates and More Restrictive Conditions

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 144-E, filed on March 1, 1956, having requested authority to make revisions regarding applicability in its tariff schedule as designated in Schedule PA-5, Irrigation Pumping Service, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2653-E, to become effective on March 31, 1956, which said revisions will impose more restrictive conditions and may result in increased charges.

It appearing that such conditions or charges as will result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2653-E effective on March 31, 1956.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheet issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheet was issued under Resolution No. E-920 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
