SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "N" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of February 28, 1956, permission to install Class "N" lines on both sides of Kolb Avenue, Monterey County, for a distance of 748 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute the violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of February 17, 1956, stated that it has no objection to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "N" circuits both sides of Kolb Avenue, Monterey County, between Fremont Boulevard and English Street, a distance of 748 feet; construction to be substantially as shown on plan map, Drawing No. 4907E-2 dated December 7, 1955 submitted with its letter of February 28, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
