R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of March 13, 1956, permission to install Class "H" lines on both sides of Hunters Point Boulevard and Hawes Street, San Francisco, for a distance of 1,343 feet and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute the violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of March 2, 1956 stated that it has no objection to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Hunters Point Boulevard, San Francisco, between Evans Avenue and Hudson Street, thence along Hawes Street to Wake Road a distance of 1,343 feet; construction to be substantially as shown on Plan Map Drawing No. 3-1453-1, dated February 7, 1956, submitted with said company's letter of March 13, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
