SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of March 13, 1956 permission to install Class "H" lines on both sides of Wildwood Road, Kern County, for a distance of 1,434 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter of March 6, 1956 expressed agreement to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Wildwood Road, Kern County, for a distance of 256 feet north of Merced Avenue and 1,178 feet south of Merced Avenue for a total distance of 1,434 feet; construction to provide space for future communication facilities and to be substantially as shown on Plan Map marked LOC. EST-B-31164, dated January 11, 1956, submitted with said company's letter of March 13, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
