WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY has submitted for filing a fifth amendment dated March 15, 1956 to a special centract dated October 1, 1947 with Kaiser Steel Corporation which fifth amendment provides for enlargement of transformer capacity to 5,000 kva at Ragle Mountain Pumping Plant and at Ragle Mountain Iron Mine under conditions that differ from the utility's filed tariffs, authorization by the Commission under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code being required, it appearing that authorization of the aforesaid fifth amendment is justified, and good cause appearing, therefore,
