SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Contract Filing Under Section 5, Paragraph A, General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY has submitted for filing a fifth amendment dated March 15, 1956 to a special contract dated October 1, 1947 with Kaiser Steel Corporation which fifth amendment provides for enlargement of transformer capacity to 5,000 kva at Eagle Mountain Pumping Plant and at Eagle Mountain Iron Mine under conditions that differ from the utility's filed tariffs, authorization by the Commission under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code being required, it appearing that authorization of the aforesaid fifth amendment is justified, and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be and it hereby is granted to California Electric Power Company under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to render the utility service under the conditions and in accordance with the terms of said fifth amendment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said fifth amendment shall be marked to show that such authorization was granted under Resolution No. E-924 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given said utility of the granting of this authorization.
