SUBJECT: **Permission to Occupy both Sides of Thoroughfare
with Class "N" Lines**

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, having requested by letter of June 20, 1956, permission to continue to occupy with Class "N" lines on both sides of North Street, for a distance of 315 feet east of Second Street, in Willows, Glenn County, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has, by letter of June 1, 1956, indicated approval of continuation of such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to continue to occupy with Class "N" circuits both sides of North Street, east from Second Street, approximately 315 feet in Willows, Glenn County, as shown on the plan map marked ID-2137, submitted with its request of June 20, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization
