SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has, by letter dated July 26, 1956, requested authorization to install Class "H" lines on both sides of Edison Street and Weber Avenue, Stockton, for a total distance of 1,902 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company by letter dated July 12, 1956, indicates it has no objection to such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Edison Street between Market Street and Main Street, a distance of 420 feet, and on both sides of Weber Avenue for a distance of 1,482 feet. The construction to be substantially as shown on Plan Map Drawing No. L.E. 66173, submitted with said company's letter of July 26, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
