SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules Which May Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice No. 150-E, filed on September 4, 1956, having requested authority to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Schedules A-5 and A-6, General Service, Schedules D-5 and D-6, Domestic Service, together with the Index of Cities, Index of Cities Appendix (Maps) and Description of Special Rate Areas, set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2702-E through 2717-E, inclusive, to become effective on October 4, 1956, which said revisions may result in increased charges, and


It appearing that such conditions as may result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2702-E through 2717-E effective on October 4, 1956.
