SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Rate Contract Filed Under
 Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96,
 Which Will Result in Increased Rates or Charges.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by letter dated August 22, 1956, has submitted a special contract dated December 29, 1955, covering the delivery of electric service to the Department of Water and Power of the City of Los Angeles, during the three-year period commencing January 1, 1956, at rates and special conditions that differ from Edison's filed tariffs and that will result in increases in the rates and charges previously applicable to such service under prior contracts, and authorization therefore being required under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code, and

WHEREAS: It appears that authorization for delivery of such service by Edison under the rates, terms and conditions of the special contract dated December 29, 1955 is justified, and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND AS A FACT that the increases in rates and charges authorized herein are justified, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company be and it is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the written contract dated December 29, 1955, with the Department of Water and Power of the City of Los Angeles, in so far as it relates to the furnishing of electric utility service by Southern California Edison Company, and to render the service described therein under the terms, charges and conditions stated therein, subject to the following condition:

The authorization contained herein shall not be construed as a finding of the reasonableness of the rates, charges, terms, or conditions under which Southern California Edison Company is furnished with energy or other services by the Department of Water and Power of the City of Los Angeles.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission shall serve a certified copy of this resolution upon Southern California Edison Company and shall forward a copy of this resolution to the Department of Water and Power of the City of Los Angeles.
