R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges and More Restrictive Conditions

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, by Advice No. 64, filed August 31, 1956, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules, as designated in its Schedule Code Key Table and Table of Contents, set forth on Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 996-E and 1005-E, respectively, to withdraw Schedules PM-1 and PM-2, Municipal Pumping Service, which said withdrawal will impose more restrictive conditions and will result in increased charges to five accounts, and to withdraw Schedules P-3 and P-4, General Pumping Power.

It appearing that such conditions or charges as will result from the above revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 996-E and 1005-E, effective on October 1, 1956.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets issued in accordance with the order herein contained shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. E-936 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
