SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Lines

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has by letter dated October 22, 1956, requested permission to continue to occupy with Class "H" Lines both sides of the following thoroughfares located near Corcoran in Kings County: 6th Avenue from Kansas to Nevada Avenue, Nevada Avenue from 6th Avenue to 5 1/2 Avenue and 5 1/2 Avenue from Nevada Avenue to Orange Avenue, a total distance of 37,507 feet

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and


WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and the Central California Telephone Company, by letters dated September 27, and September 28, 1956, respectively, indicated approval of continuation of such occupancy,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to continue to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of the following thoroughfares located near Corcoran in Kings County: 6th Avenue from Kansas to Nevada Avenue, Nevada Avenue from 6th Avenue to 5 1/2 Avenue and 5 1/2 Avenue from Nevada Avenue to Orange Avenue, a total distance of approximately 37,507 feet. The construction is shown on Local Estimate Plan Map Drawing No. IC-9034 submitted with its request of October 22, 1956.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
