SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, by letter dated January 8, 1957, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of 7th Street, between Bellflower Boulevard and the Los Cerritos Channel in Los Angeles County, and,

WHEREAS: the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and General Telephone Company of California, by letters dated December 7, 1956, and December 28, 1956, respectively, expressed no objection to the occupancy of the Class "H" lines.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Southern California Edison Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of 7th Street between Bellflower Boulevard and Los Cerritos Channel in Los Angeles County, just outside the eastern boundary of the City of Long Beach, as shown on the sketch included with its letter of January 8, 1957.

The secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
