SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by letter dated February 12, 1957, requested authorization to occupy both sides of 7th Avenue, approximately 42 miles southwest of Kingsburg, Kings County, with Class "S" circuits for a total distance of approximately 565 feet and,

MEREAS: In the absence of such permission, this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95 and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, by latter dated February 4, 1957, expressed no objection to such occupancy by said Class "R" lines.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of 7th Avenue, for a distance of approximately 565 feet, beginning at a point 58 feet more or less, south of the south line of Chico Avenue near Kingsburg, Kings County and substantially as shown on the plan map No. S-17450, submitted with said company's letter of February 12, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
