SUBJECT: Permission to Use Metal Riser Pipe Cover

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has by letter dated February 12, 1957, requested authorization to deviate from certain provisions of Rule 54.6-2 of General Order No. 95 to permit the use of a metal riser pipe cover, said riser pipe cover to be placed over a riser pipe when additional mechanical protection is necessary to offeet the effects of corrosion of the riser pipe, and

WEENEAS: It appears that the U-shaped metal riser pipe cover will provide adequate protection of the riser conductors and that safety to workmen and the public will not be lessened by use of such material and that the requested permission should be granted and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREEK ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Cas and Ricctric Company to use, under the provisions of Rule 54.6-2 of General Order No. 95, metal riser coverings as shown on the company's Drawing Number 033649 "Metal Riser Fipe Cover", submitted with the company's letter of February 12, 1957, over existing risers from the ground line to a level not less than 8 feet above the ground line, under the following conditions:

- The metal cover shall only be used to cover an existing riser pipe as a means of providing additional mechanical protection where such riser pipe is in a deteriorated condition resulting from corresion.
- 2. The metal cover shall be securely grounded.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given to Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
