SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare  
 with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has, by letter dated February 12, 1957, requested authorization to occupy both sides of Carson Street between Lakewood Boulevard and Lakewood Drive in the City of Long Beach with Class "H" circuits for a total distance of approximately 1,400 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The General Telephone Company of California, the other pole-using utility in the area, by letter dated March 27, 1957, stated that they have no objection to the proposed construction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Carson Street between Lakewood Boulevard and Lakewood Drive in the City of Long Beach for a total distance of approximately 1,400 feet as shown on plan map No. 4405-1570 and No. 4405-1571 submitted with said company's letter of February 12, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
