SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare With Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: The SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has, by letter dated May 8, 1957, requested authorization to occupy both sides of certain streets in the los Angelas area with Class "H" circuits, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission this occupance would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, the other pole-using utility in the area, by letter dated May 3, 1957, stated that they have no objection to the proposed construction, provided that the line voltage on one side of thoroughfares is not more than 16 kv.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "N" circuits, in the Los Angeles area, both sides of Fir Avenue from Inglewood substation to Queen Street, thence west on Queen Street to Inglewood Avenue, thence south on Inglewood Avenue to Compton Boulevard, thence west 2,110 feet on Compton Boulevard, as shown on sketch submitted with its letter of Nay 8, 1957, provided that the line voltage on one side of said thoroughfares does not exceed 16 kv.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
