R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has by letter dated July 3, 1957, requested authorization to occupy both sides of Highway 99 in Riverside County with Class "H" circuits; and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95; and

WHEREAS: The California Water and Telephone Company by letter dated May 31, 1957 stated that they are in approval of the proposed construction provided joint usage is established,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Highway 99 in Section 23, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, Riverside County, for a total distance of 2,955 feet as shown on drawings submitted with the company's letter of July 11, 1957, provided that space is made available for joint usage to the mutual satisfaction of prospective joint users.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
