R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare With Class "H" circuits, Per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95

WHEREAS: The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has by letter dated October 10, 1957, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Ellis Street from Santa Rosa Station "A" to Santa Rosa Avenue, a distance of approximately 329 feet in the City of Santa Rosa; and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95; and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has by letter dated October 1, 1957, indicated agreement to the proposed plan of construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Ellis Street from Santa Rosa Station "A" to Santa Rosa Avenue for a total distance of 329 feet, more or less, in the City of Santa Rosa as shown on Drawing No. OMO 138734, submitted with said company's letter of October 10, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
