R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
With Class "H" Circuits, Per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95

WHEREAS: The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has by letter dated October 10, 1957, requested authorization to continue the present occupancy of both sides of Avenue 26 from Road 23 1/2 westerly for a distance of approximately 3,951 feet, in Madera County; and


WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95; and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, the other pole-using utility in the area, has by letter dated September 26, 1957, stated that the proposed construction is agreeable to said company.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Avenue 26 from Road 23 1/2 westerly for a distance of approximately 3,951 feet, in Madera County, as shown on Drawing No. MO 6-1906-B submitted with said company's letter of October 10, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
