R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare With Class "H" Circuits, Per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95

WHEREAS: The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has by letter dated October 10, 1957, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of West San Fernando Street between Wilson Street and Sunol Street for a distance of approximately 240 feet, in the City of San Jose; and



WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95; and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, the other pole-using utility in the area, has by letter dated September 23, 1957, expressed no objections to the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of West San Fernando Street between Wilson Street and Sunol Street for a total distance of approximately 240 feet in the City of San Jose, as shown on Engineering Drawing No. 1591 submitted with said company's letter of October 10, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
