SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare With Class "H" Circuits per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95.

WHEREAS: The Pacific Gas and Electric Company has by letter dated November 1, 1957, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Pole Line Road (also known as Two Mile Road) near Maxwell, Colusa County, for a distance of approximately 163 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The California Pacific Utilities Company, the other pole-using utility in the area, has by letter dated October 8, 1957 expressed no objection to the proposed construction,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Pole Line Road (also known as Two Mile Road) for a distance of 163 feet, west of Maxwell Road, Colusa County, and substantially as shown on the plan map CM-138638 submitted with said company's letter of November 1, 1957.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
