SUBJECT: **Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Circuits per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95**

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has by letter dated January 21, 1958, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Jensen Avenue west of its intersection with Del Rey Avenue, approximately 1 1/2 miles west of Sanger, Fresno County, for a distance of 5,555 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and the Sanger Telephone Company, the other pole-using utilities in the area, by letters dated December 12, 1957 and December 18, 1957, respectively, express no objection to the occupancy of the Class "H" lines,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Jensen Avenue west of its intersection with Del Rey Avenue, approximately 1 1/2 miles west of Sanger, Fresno County, for a distance of 5,555 feet, substantially as shown on the plan map, identified as Loc. Est. E-34941, submitted with said company's letter of January 21, 1958.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
