R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Special Contract Filed under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96.

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, by letter dated January 24, 1958, submitted a letter agreement dated November 5, 1957 for the rendering of emergency standby electric service to Imperial Irrigation District, under rates and conditions which differ from the company's filed tariffs, authorization by the Commission, under Section No. 532 of the Public Utilities Code being required, and it appearing that authorization of the aforesaid letter agreement is in the public interest and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that California Electric Power Company be authorized under Section No. 532 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California to render the service and charge the rates under the conditions and in accordance with the terms of said contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract herein authorized shall be marked to show that such contract was authorized under Resolution No. E-974 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California.
