R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare with Class "H" Circuits

WHEREAS: The SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has, by letter dated March 3, 1958, requested authorization to occupy both sides of certain streets near the City of Strathmore with Class "H" circuits, and

WHEREAS: Permission for such occupancy is required by Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The General Telephone Company, the communications utility in the area, by letters dated January 21, 1957 and January 20, 1958, has stated that it has no objection to the proposed occupancy,

IT IS FOUND that the requested permission should be granted and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits near the City of Strathmore the north side of 7th Avenue from "S" Avenue to Cairns Avenue, a distance of approximately 5,080 feet, and the east side of "S" Avenue from 7th Avenue to a point approximately 1,250 feet north of 7th Avenue, the opposite sides of the aforesaid streets being occupied by the Class "H" circuits of Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Southern California Edison Company of the granting of this authorization.
