SUBJECT: Authorization for Use of a Wood Barrier in Lieu of the Horizontal Clearances Required Between the Unenergized Parts of Transformers or Unprotected Lead Wires and Buses and the Surface of a Building.

WHEREAS: The SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY has, by letter dated March 14, 1958, requested authorization to erect a wood barrier in lieu of horizontal clearances required between transformers, associated unprotected lead and bus wires, and the surface of the building located along the east property line of 3330 East Foothill Boulevard in East Pasadena, California, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission the location of this transformer structure would constitute a violation of Rules 58.3-B2 and Table 1, Case 7, and

WHEREAS: It would be impracticable to obtain said clearances by moving the transformer structure, and

WHEREAS: The building involved has no openings or windows at this location,

IT IS FOUND THAT the requested permission should be granted and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that authorization be granted the Southern California Edison Company under the provisions of Rule 58.3-B2 of General Order No. 95 to erect a wood barrier on a transformer structure located on the east property line of 3330 East Foothill Boulevard in East Pasadena, California, constructed in the manner shown by the Company's drawing numbered 427902-0 dated March 3, 1958, submitted with the Company's letter of March 14, 1958.
