SUBJECT: Permission to Occupy Both Sides of a Thoroughfare
with Class "H" Circuits per Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has, by letter dated May 8, 1958, requested authorization to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Madera Avenue between Jensen and North Avenue, near Kerman in Fresno County, for a distance of 5,376 feet, and

WHEREAS: In the absence of such permission, occupancy would constitute a violation of Rule 31.3 of General Order No. 95, and

WHEREAS: The Kerman Telephone Company, the communication utility in the area, by letter dated April 22, 1958, agrees to the occupancy provided "the presently proposed reconstruction and on any future 12 kv pole replacements in this section, space will be provided for the telephone company's use",

IT IS FOUND THAT the requested permission should be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company subject to the above provision and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be granted the Pacific Gas and Electric Company under the provisions of Rule No. 31.3 of General Order No. 95 to occupy with Class "H" circuits both sides of Madera Avenue between Jensen and North Avenue, near Kerman in Fresno County for a distance of 5,376 feet, substantially as shown on the drawing marked Loc. Est. E-35905 submitted with the company's letter of May 8, 1958, subject to the provision requested by the Kerman Telephone Company in its letter of April 22, 1958, that on the proposed reconstruction and on any future 12 kv pole replacements in this section, space be provided for the telephone company's use.

The Secretary is hereby directed to cause appropriate notice to be given the Pacific Gas and Electric Company of the granting of this authorization.
